The referenced Federal Register 29CFR Part 1910.1200(b)(6)(V) exempts "Articles" from the Hazardous Communication Standard. The subject materials are considered to be "Articles" since they are manufactured and sold to a finished specific design, have an end use function which is dependent on their as-manufactured design, and since they will not, to the best of our knowledge and belief, release or otherwise result in direct or indirect exposure of persons to a known hazardous chemical under normal conditions of use. Consequently, the requirements of the amended 29CFR Part 1910.1200 do not apply to the subject materials, and, as such, they do not require a Material Safety Data Sheet for compliance with this Standard.
